Paper submission

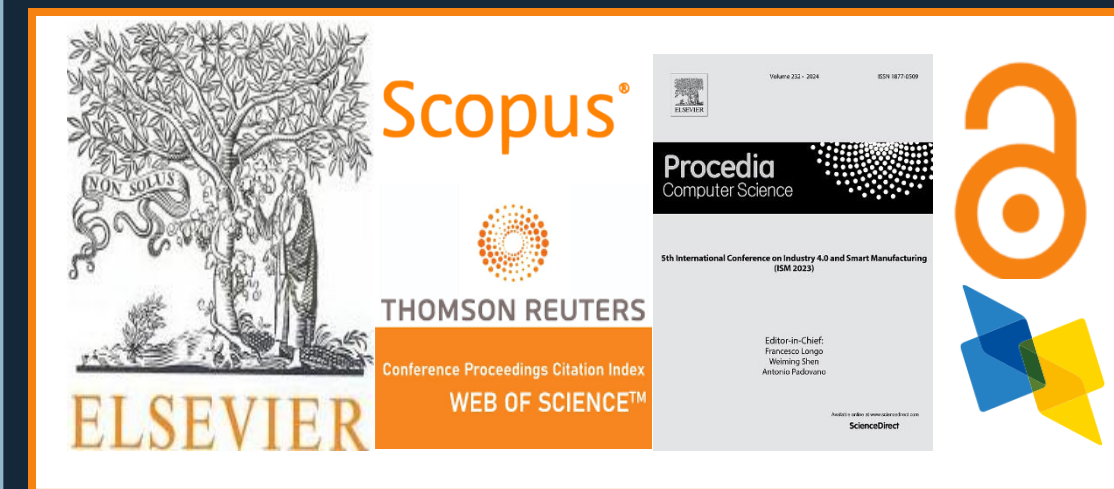
We encourage submissions that describe original unpublished work that is not currently under review for any other conference or journal. All submissions should be made via EasyChair in English and submitted as a PDF file.
