Paper submission

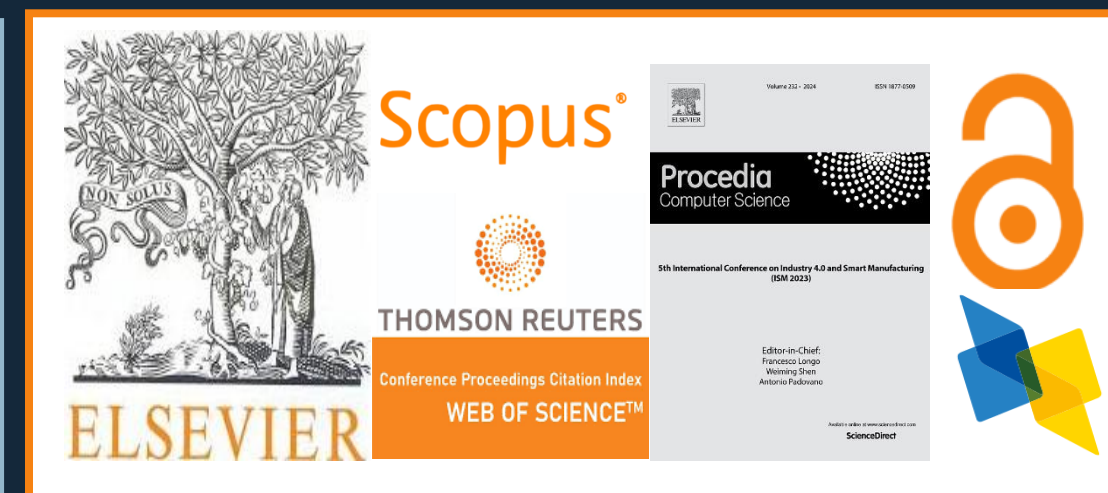
